

- 1: Remove the 3 screws and metal cover.
- 2: Remove plunger and contacts (plunger just pulls out)



4: Check parts are correct before you start to assemble.



5: Assemble in reverse order NB, the wire goes between head of bolt and contact. Re-use all o'rings / insulators.



6: Make sure all nuts are tight so there is no gap between the heads and the new copper contact.





7: Remember to put the spring under the plunger and re-use the original rubber seal. Replace the metal cover and 3 screws.
Do not over tighten screws.
The starter is ready to put back on the vehicle.
